

Capture The Coach

Overview:

Group is split into two teams; orange and pink. There are two coaches (“flags”), one with each color shirt (one pink coach, one orange coach). Think of a combination relay race, manhunt, obstacle course.

Objective: To receive as many points as possible by finding the “coach” on the mountain. “Flags” can be found in any area accessible to the Hogsback or Skyline chairlifts (including Daisy and the Carpets).

Scoring:

Receive **1 points** by completing a task from the coach of your team’s color. This is a task within YOUR team’s ability level. (1 point)

Receive **2 points** by completing a task from a coach of a different color. These tasks will be one level higher than your designated level. (2 points)

At least 50% of your group has to successfully complete the task. Coaches can instruct but not participate.

Popsicle sticks must be brought down to ski school after each task from a “coach” and left with the “gatekeeper.” After successful completion of a task you bring your stick down to the gatekeeper. Each group can only have one popsicle stick in their possession at a time. Collection cups will be located either in Lauren’s or Sydney’s windows.

If a task is not successful then the team must take a lap before they can challenge the same flag. They can choose to try the same task again or receive another. The team may practice the task and try again. The Coach may have moved by the time you get back so hurry!

Challenges:

If two groups of opposing teams are at the flag at the same time, The group that came second can choose to challenge or take a lap. If they approach the flag after a group has started their task, take a lap.

Challenge: The team that completes the challenge most successfully gets a golden popsicle stick. The “flag” is judge.

- more team members successful
- tasks performed while team chant is sang
- task goals demonstrated better
- best sportsmanship
- Trivia questions will be used as tie breakers.

Safe Zones: All of the base area around the lodges is a safe zone including all lifts, and the lodges. The top of all chair-lifts is a safe zone. You are not allowed to wait for flags at the top of the chair-lifts to follow them. Flags can wait in safe zones as long as they want until all groups have left so that they can go down a run with no-one watching.

Off-Limits areas: The Top Phlight terrain park is off-limits. All freestyle tasks are outside-in ready and do not need to be completed in a park, although they can be. Skiing through trees is off-limits unless skiing on common trails such as squirrel-trail, murk woods, etc. Flags may be found in such places.
