2018- WA State Laws

As of Jan 1st 2018, in accordance to the new Washington State Laws all employee's will begin to accrue **sick time** from Jan 1st onward. More details on this topic to come!

As of Jan 1st 2018, the Washington State Minimum Wage will increase from \$11.00 to \$11.50. What does this mean for us...?

- **-Full Time Instructors**—your most recent pay rate will remain the same
- **-Part Time Instructors**—your teach rate will remain the same; your non-teach rate will increase to \$11.50
- -Hourly Staff—if your current pay rate is below \$11.50 you will increase to \$11.50 *All other increase are subject to your pay scale for your position
