Policy Reminders

Please remember that *"smoking and the use of tobacco products is not permitted in the workplace. If you are on a break (off the clock), and wish to smoke, you must be in a designated smoking area. Do not wear your uniform while smoking as the odor lingers and customers can smell it. You may be formally disciplined if your jacket smells of smoke."*
