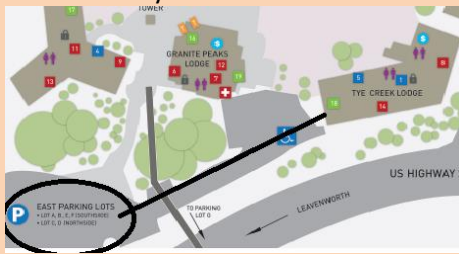

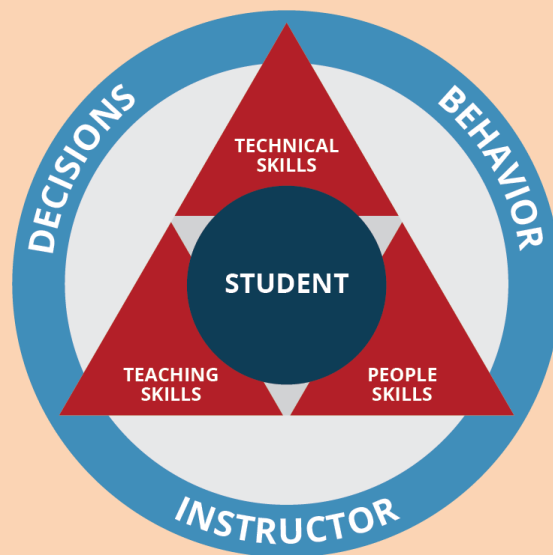
## National Academy 2019
