While the Ski and Snowboard School is still ramping up, we do expect large guest numbers here both days and we still have very limited terrain available - only 4 lifts running as I type. It is the combination of these factors that mean we would like to limit access where possible. This is not a decision taken lightly and is not something that will happen every busy day or every weekend. This is just something that we consider while our snowpack is thin and our skiable terrain is heavily reduced. As a result, with the forecast looking positive we are hopeful of opening more terrain ASAP and returning to normal access after the weekend. I also know that many of you have been looking forward to getting up here to work as well as play and a late opening makes that a little more challenging.
