Did you know?



In the 2019-20 Season, Vail Resorts and Helly Hansen released a collaborative winter jacket that had some unique features. The jacket included a built-in Epic Pass which gave the wearer access to all of Vail Resorts ski areas around the world. The purchase of the jacket also included guided tours, first track experiences, and a complimentary on-mountain lunch. These were limited to 100 men's and 100 women's jackets and retailed for \$1,052 (the exact vertical rise of Vail Mountain in meters.) Active team members at Stevens are eligible for the Helly Hansen Pro
