## **CERTIFICATION CLINIC SERIES**

Before you submit your schedule, consider your certification goals. When can you schedule time each week to devote to your professional development? Skiing and snowboarding on snow clinics series will be held for all certification levels 1,2 and 3, twice each week through the middle of the season. There will be a weekly online technical session, Tuesday evenings for both skiers and snowboarders. The Certification clinic series will begin on Tuesday 1/5/21 and end on Sunday 2/28/21. The series will cover different topics for 8 weeks to prepare instructors for their exams running on both Wednesday afternoons or Sunday evenings. I would encourage exam candidates to attend an entire series and online sessions if possible, however attending individual clinics will be an effective way to get much of the information and practice.

Online - Tuesday 6:00pm to 7:00pm (Alpine) 7:00pm to 8:00pm (Snowboard) - This weekday online meeting will cover certification topics that will be covered each week as part of the certification series. The first half hour of the meeting will focus on L1 introductory aspects of the series topic, the last half hour of the discussion will focus on the same topic for Level 2 & 3.

On Snow - Wednesday 1:30pm to 3:00pm - This weekday certification clinic series is an opportunity for full time and MW instructors to attend training on their day off or prior to the MW evening lessons that begin at 4pm. Level 1 and level 2/3 clinics for both skiing and snowboarding will be offered.

On Snow - Sunday 4:30pm to 6:00pm - This weekend certification clinics is scheduled during a traditionally less busy time period for lessons and instructor assignments. Sunday evenings are an opportunity for both full time and part time instructors to work toward their certification goal, we will hold level 1 and level 2/3 clinics for both skiing and snowboarding.

### **LEVEL 1 EXAM DATES**

Save the date, these are the PSIA/AASI Level 1 Exam dates for Stevens Pass. The March exams will be held mid-week, to not interfere with multi-week program lessons. We are advertising these dates early to give you time to adjust your work and life schedule to prioritize certification. The early exam is only for instructors with experience who have elective training hours from last season. If these dates do not work with your schedule, checkout psia-nw.org for more options.
