ONBOARDING:

What should I know before I show up to Check In?

- 1. Make a reservation for your onboarding check in here!
- Ensure that you have completed your Day 1 LIFT Training the day prior to your scheduled onboarding check in. The LIFT training will take approximately 3.5 hours to complete and includes the Ready for winter, COVID Response, and Skier Responsibilities modules.
- 3. In this training, you will learn about the required daily health screenings. In the morning, before you arrive for onboarding, please complete the **health-screening questionnaire** found on the Epic Employee App or at EpicEmployee.Vailresorts.com This screening is to be completed at home before you come up, at latest prior to leaving your vehicle when you arrive on site.
 - I. If you do not have a thermometer please still preform the screening in relation to the symptoms and the questions regarding exposure. If you cannot take your temperature but feel normal you may come to work at which time you receive a thermometer immediately. If you have any concerns about your temperature at home you should not come up.
- II. Everyone will be provided with a thermometer to keep at check-in!
- 4. Complete your **Ski Waiver** in the "Required Notices" in EpicEmployee.

New Employees complete your I-9 documents online in epic employee and bring your I-9 physical documents. The acceptable documents can be found here!
