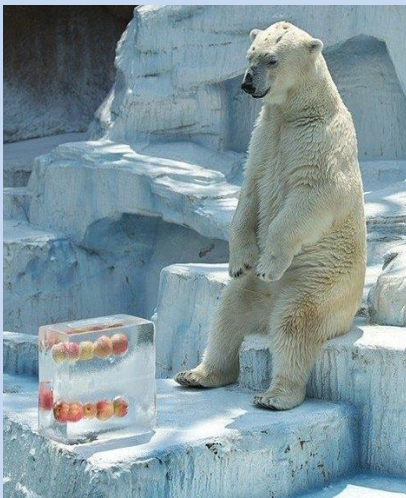

Full Day Kids Lesson Change

In accordance with changes to indoor dining protocols in WA state we have made an adjustment to our Kids Group Lesson offerings. We will no longer be offering full day lessons with lunch. BE SAFE TOGETHER

We want you to be successful from day 1, and we want everyone to go home safe and well every day. Here are some key messages that are critical we all observe and hold each other accountable to:
