# Youth Program Reminders!

With some of the recent changes, we have many instructors bouncing back and forth between adult programs and youth programs. Here are a few reminders when working in youth:

- Vests and leg bands <u>must</u> stay on students at all times during lesson
- Per Covid SOPs, no eating or drinking inside (you may take snack or water breaks outside)
- All students and coaches must return back to the corral before checking students out to parents at the end of the lesson
- Vests and leg bands <u>must</u> stay on students until we have seen the claim tickets from the parents
- Children in youth programs lessons <u>cannot</u> ride chairlifts without a safety bar during lesson time (*Kehrs*, 7<sup>th</sup>)
- 7-12 year olds <u>must</u> ride with a classmate or coach from the same group. 5-6 year olds must ride with an employee.
