Training Corner

What training am I required to complete prior to work?

Navigating the required training for Vail and the Stevens Pass Ski and Snowboard School (SSBS) can be a bit tricky as you will receive many email reminders and updates from us. To make things easier, there are two main training components to prepare you for the season ahead:

The first is Vail company orientation videos through "The LIFT". These trainings will be assigned to you automatically once you are an active employee. Expect to see emails sent to you regarding these training videos in early to mid-November.

The second component to required training is Department training, this will look differently based on your role and if you are a new or returning employee. For more details about your specific requirements check out our department website HERE. The SSBS training events will happen from mid November to **December 24**th, 2001, which is the deadline for

completing all required training.
