

Returning Instructor On Snow Training

How do I sign up for additional training in the LIFT?

- 1. Once you are logged in to <u>the LIFT</u>, either click **Browse** to view the Learning Catalog or click on the **Search** function (magnifying glass icon) to type in a specific class that you would like to register for. Both of these options are located in the upper right-hand corner of the homepage.
 - 2. Click on View Classes to see specific time and date offerings of that class.
- 3. Select **Enroll** for the desired date/time. Some classes are offered completely online and can be taken at any time.
