We also made easy choices, choices aimed at maximizing your experience as a member of our school family.

New Multi-Week programs - Base Camp, D Team and Snowsports teams will be streamlined into Base Camp and High Camp. Alicia will be developing these programs with building community as the primary driver

New school organizational structure - The school will function under two full-time, year round managers. Their functions will be divided based on the interaction that our guests have with the school. This can be defined as a daily or "dating" product and a recurring or "relationship" type product. More information to follow in the Word!

New communication strategies - The WORD is now a perennial vehicle for staying connected. We are also initiating a new guest communication platform that streamlines information to guests based on its level of relevance and interest.

Expanded training and development opportunities - lead by world class leaders in snowsports instruction, our on-snow and off-snow training will be expanded and will now include leadership development opportunities!

This will be supported by new school signage that is clear and concise. Finally, a new POD structure within the school to enabling closer connection with everyone for sharing information and feedback.
