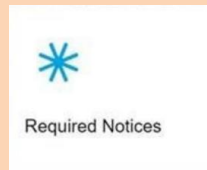

Your pass will become active based on your activation date AND the completion of all required notices which can be accessed in the Epic Employee App. Click on the Direct Connect Take Action tile → Required Notices. The following waivers will appear and must be acknowledged in order to activate your pass:



- Ski/Activity Waiver
- Employee Guide Acknowledgment
- Wage & Hour Attestation Form
- Form I-9 (only for new employees)
- Flexible Remote Work Policy

New Employees: Passes and benefit coupons can be picked up on your Indoor training date/I9 check in date.

Returning Employees: If you need to pick up a new Employee or Dependent Pass or Benefit Coupons the Ticket Office will be open Mon-Sun, 9am – 3pm.
