Happy Holiday time everyone! We hope you all are having a good holiday season. We have had a great start to our season with a strong assist from mother nature.

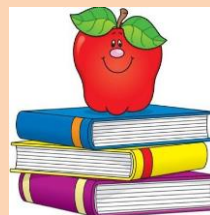
- We have taught over 650 first timers.

## Have You Checked Your Schedule Lately?

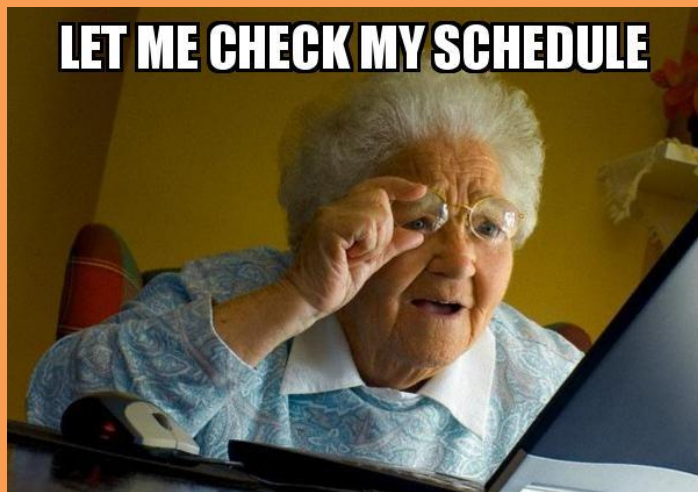
