On-Snow Readiness

As we near opening and/or on-snow training, we want to make sure you have all the pieces/info to be successful.

First, if you missed picking up your **uniform**, we can pull this for you ahead of time. Simply <u>complete this form</u> and we will have it ready in the locker room.

For **employee season passes**: if you have yours from last season, those should activate upon completion of all required onboarding tasks. For new employees, you can pick these up at the Granite Peaks Lodge pass office. The pass office is open everyday during from 9a-3p. Again, all onboarding tasks will need to be completed first.

Having an active employee season pass is needed to ski/ride the mountain, check your schedule and to access on mountain discounts in F&B and our Retail outlets.

Gear Inspection: For snowboarders who still need to complete the inspection process, we can do this in dept. on your first day. Simply let us know and we will walk through the process with you. For skiers, the repair shop will be accepting gear Monday Nov 27 - Nov 29 from 9am-3pm. As well, daily, once we are open.
