Employee Alert: Waiver Signing Required

To streamline our processes, we've introduced Meal and Rest Period Verification forms for Stevens Pass employees.

Additionally, Washington Rest Break and Meal Period Requirements are

crucial to understand:

Rest Breaks: One paid 10-minute break for every 4 hours worked. No clocking out, and breaks should ideally be scheduled every 2 hours.

Meal Periods: Varied requirements based on hours worked. Employees working 5 hours or more are entitled to an unpaid 30-minute meal period. If choosing to waive, specific guidelines apply.

Look out for the waiver, coming soon. If you have already signed a waiver then no extra steps are required. You have the option of completing a physical form, however, a digital form may be sent out to those who have not completed one.
