PSIA Level 2 standard (or equivalent) skiing riding ability recommended.

"Experience the backcountry" in touring mode. This will be an uphill experience that utilizes lift access.

Strictly limited to 6 participants.
Full ski touring kit required (shovel, beacon, probe, backpack, skins, touring binding, touring skis or split board equivalent)
PSIA Level 2 standard (or equivalent) skiing riding ability recommended.
